# New lease of life at historic site as salon moves in

**IPSWICH:** An historic building is set to be given a new lease of life as work is under way to create a beauty salon.

Image Salon, which is currently based in Old Foundry Road, has been open 11 years but the owner Sue Carter said in the last three years they have been busier than ever and need to relocate to expand.

Ms Carter had been looking for new premises for some time before she came across an architectural gem on the corner of Old Foundry Road and Great Colman Street, which dates back to the 1800s. It is one of many old buildings in the town centre which have not been in use for some time.

The building was a private residence at first before changing into a pub, The Marquis of Cornwallis, in the mid-1850s. Since that closed, it has had many uses including a dentist surgery and the Community Resource Centre.

Ms Carter bought the new site, which is six

times bigger than her current salon, and work began in January. It is on course to finish in June.

She said: "It was in a terrible condition - we have put new floors and a new roof in. It is a very unusual building with lots of curves.

"I was born in Ipswich and the growth of the town means a huge amount to me.

"We had been looking for ages for the right building. I could tell it was a beautiful building and it really lends itself to being a salon."

The new expanded salon is set to include two double treatment rooms, an academy, and roof-top terrace where clients can relax. There are also energy-efficient measures being put in place, like infra-red heating.

Ms Carter added: "We are so successful now that we have outgrown our current site. The new place will be lovely for our clients. "We are really excited about moving in there."
